We appreciate your interest in adopting a pet bird from Animal Services of Richmond, Inc. Birds require different care than dogs, cats, rabbits, or rodents. Because caring for a bird is a serious responsibility and can be more of a challenge than with a cat or a dog, Richmond Wildlife Center has developed this questionnaire to aid us in making the best placement possible for the bird and you. The adoption process will take some time. We want to match each bird up with the right home and we want you to have all the necessary information and support you need for a successful adoption. We thank you for your patience and cooperation through the process. Please be aware of the following: You must be 21 years of age or older to adopt a bird. The adoption process may include a home visit depending on species applying to adopt. You will be required to show what type of cage you will use to house the bird and demonstrate that you are able to adequately care for a bird. We may also ask you to provide veterinary records on birds currently in the home.
